**REVIEW OF RESULTS FOR PERIOD ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2006 (1Q07) vs QUARTER ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2005 (1Q06)**

**Turnover**

Revenue for the quarter ended 30 September 2006 rose 24% to S\$55.3m from \$44.5m while gross profit rose 68% from \$8.3m to \$14.0m when compared to the previous corresponding quarter. The increase in revenue and gross profit was due mainly to better selling prices and strong demand for the Group's steel products.

Other operating income of \$1.3m compared to \$0.2m was due to a one time non recurring receipt arising from the early redemption of a bond held by the Company.

**Staff costs, Depreciation, Other operating expenses and Finance cost**

Staff costs rose 24% to \$2.5m from \$2.0m due to higher provision for incentives arising from better profit and higher sales.

Other operating expenses rose 61% to \$2.5m from \$1.6m was in tandem with higher sales. The lower amount registered in the previous corresponding quarter was also caused by a write-back of allowance for slow and obsolete inventories of \$0.4m.

Net finance cost of \$231k was 42% lower than \$397k incurred previously due to lower balance of borrowings of \$21.8m compared to \$30.0m recorded in the last corresponding period. These borrowings were mainly made up of trust receipts incurred in the normal course of business. The lower balance was also due to foreign exchange gain (realised and unrealised) arising from the weakening of the USD in the quarter ended 30 September 2006.

**Profitability review**

Profit after tax rose 126% to \$7.8m compared to \$3.4m in the corresponding quarter was mainly due to better selling price and higher volume. The higher profit was boosted by a one time non recurring receipt of \$0.9m arising from the early redemption of a bond held by the Company.

## **REVIEW OF FINANCIAL POSITION AS AT 30 SEPTEMBER 2006**

### **Non current assets**

The balance of available-for-sale financial assets decreased to \$8.9m from \$11.4m was due to the redemption of a bond that the Company held earlier.

### **Current assets and current liabilities**

Inventories balance rose to \$52.3m from \$44.4m reflected the Group's effort to replenish and maintain a comprehensive range of products to meet the needs of its customers.

Trade and other receivables rose slightly to \$55.6m from \$53.6m as a result of higher sales registered in the quarter ended 30 September 2006.

Trade payables and other payables also increased from \$10.2m to \$12.3m in line with higher inventories holding.

Borrowings increased to \$21.8m from \$17.7m due to higher inventories purchases and were mainly made up of trust receipts.

### **Share capital and reserves**

The balance of fair value reserve was lowered to \$1.4m from \$1.9m mainly due to the redemption of a bond held by the company.

Demand for the Group's products is expected to remain strong for the rest of the calendar year due to the sustained activities in the shipbuilding, oil and gas sectors. The Group will also expect to supply to construction projects expected to begin in the coming months like the Integrated Resorts.

Margin for its steel plates which had been recovering since the last quarter is expected to remain stable in the coming months. With the anticipated strong demand, margins for its other steel products are also expected to remain stable for the rest of the calendar year.

The Group will ensure its purchasing activities will provide it with an adequate supply and a comprehensive range of products to meet market demands.
