REVIEW OF OPERATING PERFORMANCE FOR THE QUARTER ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2009 ('2QFY10') vs QUARTER ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2008 ('2QFY09')

Turnover for 2QFY10 was \$43.8M, representing an increase of approximately 19% over 1QFY10 of \$36.9M. The better performance was mainly due to improved demand experienced during the reporting quarter.

However turnover was 53% lower than the reported turnover of \$92.5M for 2QFY09. The decline was largely a reflection of the weak economic conditions prevailing in 2009 caused by the global financial crisis in 2008.

Gross profit for 2QFY10 was \$8.4M (1QFY10: \$5.9M) declining 14% from \$9.8M in 2QFY09 mainly as a result of the lower revenue reported.

However the Group generated gross profit margin of 19.3% for 2QFY10 (1QFY10: 15.9%) which was an improvement from the gross profit margin of 10.6% achieved in the corresponding quarter of 2QFY09. The better gross profit margin was partially caused by a write back of \$1.5M previously provided for the

impairment in inventory value while there was a write-down of \$5.7M instead in 2QFY09. These figures also showed selling prices have remained firm since 1QFY10.

Staff costs, Other operating expenses and Finance cost

The decline in staff costs in 2QFY10 to \$2.0M from \$2.5M (2QFY09) was mainly due to lower provision of incentives, lower headcount, salaries reduction implemented in calendar year 2009 and receipt from the Job Credit Scheme.

Other operating expenses for 2QFY10 declined to \$2.7M from \$3.4M (2QFY09) mainly due to the reduction in trading activities arising from the smaller sales volume reported. Various cost cutting measures implemented during the calendar year 2009 also contributed to the lower costs incurred. An impairment loss of \$496K taken up in 2QFY09, relating to available-for-sale financial assets also caused the amount to become higher in the corresponding period.

Finance cost-net in 2QFY10 was made up of interest expense of \$21K (2QFY09: \$624K) which was offset by an exchange gain of \$53K (2QFY09: loss of \$1.68M) resulting in a net gain of \$32K compared to an expense of \$2.3M for 2QFY09. The Group incurred lower interest expense as it continued with effort to pay down its borrowings coupled with its reduced purchasing programme in respond to the weak market demand for steel products. As a result, the Group borrowings stood at \$1.4M at the end 2QFY10 (2QFY09: \$57.2M). Part of these borrowings were in the form of US dollar denominated trust receipts and the Group benefitted from the weakening of the US dollar against the Singapore dollar.

Profit attributable to equity holders of the Company

Profit after tax for 2QFY10 rose 104% to \$3.1M from \$1.5M for 2QFY09 despite reporting a lower turnover. In 1QFY10, the Group achieved \$1.9M in profit after tax.

Cash flow

The Group continued to generate a net cash inflow from operating activities during the quarter through cautious and selective inventories purchases and sustained collection effort on its trade receivables. The cash collected was then deployed to the early settlement of trust receipts thereby reducing interest expense incurred.

REVIEW OF FINANCIAL POSITION AS AT 31 DECEMBER 2009

Current assets and current liabilities

During the quarter, the Group kept up its collection effort which resulted in its balance of trade and other receivables decreasing to \$42.6M from \$62.5M (4QFY09). The lower quarterly sales also contributed to the lower outstanding balance.

With the Group exercising caution in inventory replenishment and selling from its inventory holding, its inventory balance further decreased to \$56.4M from \$67.1M (4QFY09).

Trade and other payables decreased to \$14.1M from \$20.9M while borrowings also reduced to \$1.4M from \$4.2M as the Group made fewer inventory purchases and paid its debts as they fell due. The Group posted an even higher current ratio of 9.7 times (4QFY09: 6.4 times) and a net cash position for the quarter.

Share capital and reserves

During the quarter, the Group exercised its Share Buyback Mandate and purchased \$430K worth of its own shares from the open market and these are now held as Treasury shares.

Fair value reserve arising from available-for-sale financial assets rose to \$1.0M from \$473K as values of quoted equities have been recovering since the end of 4QFY09.

During the quarter, the Group made payment for the approved final tax-exempt dividend of 1 cent/share (approximately \$6.3M) with respect to the financial year ended 30 June 2009. The net effect of this distribution and the Group's reported profit for the six months ended 31 Dec 2009 resulted in the decrease in retained earnings to \$93.7M from \$94.9M as at 30 June 2009.

Although the Group experienced improvement in demand for its structural steel products in 2QFY10, customers are still cautious with their purchases as they are uncertain about the pace of recovery in the local economy in the next few quarters. As such, demand for structural steel products is likely to remain unchanged in the near term.

Most mills are feeling pressure from high raw material costs eg. iron ore and coke and high production costs eg. oil which may lead to eventual price hikes. So far, price increases have been moderate due to the slow recovery in market demand.

Demand for pipes and fittings is also expected to remain stable and the Group is looking forward to customers restarting projects that were postponed last year due to the economic crisis. Prices have remained relatively stable but it will also face similar pressure for upward adjustments as structural steel products.

The Group continues to monitor its inventory replenishment activities closely so that it can meet customers requirement on a timely basis.

With the economy recovering slower than desired, the Group remains vigilant in controlling costs, improving efficiency and delivering value-added services to our customers which will enhance our long term competitiveness.
