Singapore, 10 February 2010 - SGX Main Board-listed HUPSteel Limited (“HUPSteel” or “the Group”), today announced that the Group achieved revenue of \$43.8M (1QFY10: 36.9M; 2QFY09: \$92.5M) for the quarter ended 31 December 2009 (‘2QFY10’) with net profit after tax of \$3.1M (1QFY10: \$1.9M; 2QFY09: \$1.5M) and declares an interim dividend of 0.5 cent per share.

The Group has maintained a strong cash position with cash and cash equivalents of \$71.9M at the end of 2QFY10 (1QFY10: \$72.5M). Despite better revenue generated during the quarter, the Group continued to monitor its purchasing activities closely and trimmed its inventory holding to \$56.4M (1QFY10: \$59.2M) and maintained low short term borrowings of \$1.4M (1QFY10: \$1.4M).

Mr Lim Kim Thor, CEO of Hupsteel, commented, “During the quarter, we saw increase in demand from the shipbuilding sector which, together with stable selling prices contributed to the higher revenue reported than a quarter ago. Improved margin also led to profit after tax rising 63% to \$3.1M from \$1.9M in 1QFY10”.

“Going forward, market demand for steel products will largely depend on the pace of economic recovery. Many customers remain cautious in their purchases and the Group is expected to conduct more of its business on a back to back basis. This will help the Group to respond swiftly to price fluctuations and avoid over-stocking its inventories.

With a strong cash balance and minimal borrowings, the Group is well positioned to seize opportunities as they arise as the economy further recovers. As business volume is showing signs of improvement, the Group has started to redevelop its warehouse at 155 Gul Circle. The redevelopment will provide improved storage facilities for its structural steel products.” concluded Mr Lim.
